

INFORMATION ABOUT MYSTHAVEN

General Info

Mysthaven is run by a husband and wife team who purchased the land 6 years ago and built the existing structure on the property. It is beautiful and very new.

The rooms are colourful, clean and new. The floors are mostly hardwood and guests are asked to leave their shoes at the door and wear indoor shoes or slippers.

The group room has hardwood floors so participants will need a comfortable mat. If you do not have such a mat to bring please speak to Janice.

Food

To date Mysthaven has been supportive of special dietary needs. There is an outdoor hot tub and also a fire pit. Firewood is provided. There is an indoor shower/sauna. There is also canoeing and a pedal boat depending on what the weather is like at that time. There are a couple of rooms to congregate in after meals. There is an elevator from the main level, where the group room, living room and meal room are. The property has extensive walking trails.

For people coming from Toronto, it is past Bethesda Road and on the right side.
